\*Ed and Mike from Lola's mentor and/or cook. They don't repeat a recipe within a year.

\*2 dinners are delivered a week. Gift cards and grocery deliveries are also provided to families.

\*There is a summer camp offering for kids, and there are cooking classes offered to kids and adults.

\*To qualify, you need a cancer diagnosis with doctor confirmation.

\*If you are not home to receive meals, a cooler must be left outside.

\*Most recipients are referred by a friend or family member. Vasser and Health Quest also refer families.

\* The Sparrow's Nest Superhero Color Run was held on September 9<sup>th</sup>.

\*To help spread the word, make guidance counselors aware of services.

\*850,000 individuals have been served by Sparrow's Nest.
